CELEBRATION OF FOURTH TO OUTSTRIP ALL

Even Inaugural Pageants to Be Dimmed By International Peace Display Here.

Once more all roads will lead to Washington next Friday when a pageant, of proportions and splendor probably never witnessed even in this city, will be staged in celebration of the signing of the peace treaty.

All plans have already been completed, it was said today at the offices of the War Camp Community Service which has charge of the arrangements.

Representatives of all the nations, with the exception of our late enemies, will take part. The pageant will be international.

President Can't Attend. Although delay in the signing of the peace treaty has made it impossible for President Wilson to attend in person, the pageant will lose nothing of its splendor. It is possible the President will send a special message. Word is also expected from Marshal Foch and General Pershing.

Those fortunate enough to have seen a Presidential inauguration here in past years may form an idea of the great crowds that will flock to Washington from all parts of the country. The streets will be just as crowded, only more so. There will be more military bands and the din and noise and festivities will be greater, too. Excitement will run higher. The blue sky alone will be the limit.

The festival, which is in three divisions, was written and arranged by Mrs. Marie Moore Forest, director of drama and pageantry of the War Camp Community Service, and general director of the celebration. Her assistants are Miss Marjorie Day, Mrs. Florence Lyon and Mrs. Maude Howell Smith. Associated with them is the following committee: Ruth Jane Bauske, Miss Eunice Ensor, Mrs. Glenna Smith Tinnin, Victor J. Evans, Mrs. Genevieve Turner Holman, Mrs. Alice Torbet, Miss Elizabeth Schreiner, Denis Connell, Miss Norma Schwenzler, Mrs. Corrine Lockman, Miss Mary Ellen Glass, E. W. Bond, Miss Evangeline Mickler, Mrs. Carrie Watson, and Frank Wells.

The Call to the Service. The first bugle call will mark "The Call to the Service of Mankind" and will be under the direction of Miss Edna Heineman of New York. The Red Cross, the Y. M. C. A., the Y. W. C. A., Knights of Columbus, Jewish Welfare Board, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Salvation Army, Associated Charities, and the War Camp Community Service will take part in accompanying marches and songs.

Front of the D. A. B. building the Lithuanian choir from St. Alphonse Church of Baltimore will sing, followed by folk dances of one of the young nations that have been established through the war.

At the Pan American Building "commerce, business and the professions" will make their appeal to the uniformed men. The Japanese dancer, Michio Ito, will give two solo dances, and the Japanese prima donna, Madame Tamaki Miura, will sing.

One of the greatest spectacles of the pageant will stage on the Ellipse, where gorgeous floats will be seen. Around the pageant's outer circle a "march of organized labor" will be held.

The Call of Art. The "Call of Art" will be portrayed on the south front of the Treasury by the Rhythmic Players Club, under the direction of Mrs. Tinnin. The Department of Agriculture grounds will be the scene of the "Call of the Land." Girls will send forth the call of the goddess Ceres, Pomona and Flora.

On the south front of the New Museum building will be shown a pageant called "The Offering of Peace." The parade will leave the south front of the Treasury at 7 o'clock and the floats will be preceded by the grand marshal, Lieut. Gen. Robert L. Bullard and his aides.

Five spectacles will make up the third division of the festival. The greatest of them—and perhaps of the entire celebration, for that matter, will show the United States and the countries of the world under the dominion of the Spirit of Love. This chief character will be portrayed by Flora McGill Keefer.

Firework in Evening. In the evening, beginning at 9:30, there will be a two-hour display of fireworks.

All of which promises the coming festival the greatest Fourth of July celebration held.
