

**IMBECILE IS CURED  
BY FLESH OF APE**

"Fountain of Youth" Works  
Miraculous Transformation on  
Boy Unable to Speak.

PARIS, Oct. 14.—Has the fabled  
fountain of youth been discovered?  
Perhaps.

But it is already a positive fact  
that man is worth as much as his  
interstitial gland. This saying should  
now replace the old one that "A man  
is worth as much as his arteries."  
At the same time, the American  
public should not be misled into be-  
lieving the mystery of life has been  
solved. I assert this:  
An enormous step has been taken  
toward the abolition of old age and  
decay.

It is already a mathematical success  
with animals, but not yet with human  
beings, chiefly owing to the lack of  
opportunities to test men.

It is now a fact, accepted by scien-  
tists, that glands secrete fluids of  
various kinds which supply the vital or-  
gans with that particular sort of  
energy required by each for the exer-  
cise of its proper function.

Stores Up Energy.  
Take, for instance, the thyroid  
gland. Through some mysterious pro-  
cess this gland draws from the body  
and stores up liquid matter which it  
discharges to the brain as required.  
Without this gland the brain sinks  
into atrophy and becomes a blank.

In the same manner the interstitial  
glands appear to supply every organ  
of the body with a fund of energy.  
This I have proved by experiment.  
It suffices to take the glands from the  
body of a young vigorous healthy  
animal and graft them into the flesh  
of some decrepit animal in order to  
restore the latter's youth and vigor.

It is the question of applying the  
discovery to human kind that presents  
a ticklish problem—for where are we  
to get the young glands for the treat-  
ment of old men and women?

Ape's Blood Like Man's.  
Thanks to experiments, we know  
that the blood of the ape is exactly  
the same as a man's from which we  
draw the conclusion that since the  
glands draw a supply of vital fluid  
from the ape's blood, the glands in a  
man's body must perform essentially  
the same function, secreting a similar  
fluid.

At present it is impossible to con-  
clude from a scientific viewpoint that  
the secret of eternal youth of man  
has been discovered. It is true that  
success has been attained in the case  
of at least one aged Parisian who not  
long ago was broken down by the  
battles of life. He is today back in  
harness, full of youthful vigor, ambi-  
tion, and zest for life, thanks to a sim-  
ple operation I performed upon him.

His Youth Restored.  
Seven months ago he came to my  
laboratory. Sixty-six years of strenu-  
ous labor had bent his form, whitened  
his hair, and nipped his vitality.  
Life held nothing further for him, he  
said, so he was willing to take the  
chance of an operation of grafting  
interstitial glands.

I selected a healthy specimen of an  
anthropoid ape, from which I removed  
the vitalizing glands. Then, applying  
my local anesthetic, I made  
small incisions in the patient's flesh,  
inserted the ape's glands, and sowed  
up the wounds. Within two months  
the patient's disease had united per-  
fectly with the foreign flesh grafted  
into his own, and he was on the high  
way to rejuvenation, which today is  
complete.

Mental Vigor Restored.  
He now reacts as normally as a child.  
He has the mental and physical vigor  
of a man of thirty-five or forty.

Another man was operated upon  
three months ago. His condition  
gives every reason to expect he will  
be as fortunate as my first patient.

I recall the success with which I  
treated an imbecile in 1914 by means  
of grafting a thyroid gland into his  
flesh. He was a boy of fourteen.  
When brought to my clinic he was  
unable to speak. I took a thyroid  
gland from a monkey and grafted it  
in. Within two weeks this gland sup-  
plied the secretions formerly absent  
in the boy's brain. The boy learned  
to talk, read, and act the same as a  
normal child of eight years.
