HUERTA TAKES OFFICE; IS ILL

New Provisional President of Mexico Threatened With Appendicitis.

MEXICO CITY, June 2.—Provisional President Adolfo de la Huerta, who took the oath of office yesterday, assumed his executive duties today despite an attack of illness that threatened to develop into appendicitis.

The Chinese minister was the only member of the diplomatic corps to attend the inaugural ceremonies before the Mexican congress. The galleries were filled, and the new President was cheered by spectators in the building and those who lined the streets outside.

President de la Huerta was so weak from illness he could not attend the formal presidential reception in the national palace, but quickly returned to his hotel escorted by a detachment of troops.

Outlines His Program. The new provisional president has outlined his program as follows: First—Betterment of living conditions for the masses. Second—Encouragement to private enterprises for the exploitation of Mexico's natural resources. Third—Encouragement of diplomatic and commercial relations between Mexico and other nations. All Mexicans now living in exile will be permitted to return except those guilty of crime. Regarding Ygnacio Bonillas, the former Mexican ambassador to Washington, it was said that if Bonillas is proven a citizen of a foreign country he will be deported. This reference was to recent reports that Bonillas is really a citizen of the United States. Gen. Juan Barragan, Carranza's former chief of staff, and others who were arrested after the assassination of the late President, will be released from prison if it is found they had no hand in Carranza's death, it was declared. Announcement of the following ministerial appointments was made: Minister of war—General P. Elias

THINK WILSON WILL LET CONGRESS QUIT

President Then Expected to Re-convene It With Censure About July 19.

President Wilson is not expected to block adjournment by Congress should the Senate today follow the lead of the House which yesterday voted to adjourn June 5.

White House officials today refused to make any comment as to the president's course, but it generally is believed Democrats in both branches of Congress have been informed the President will not interfere with the proposed program. Should Congress adjourn, the President, it is said, will reconvene it about July 19 on the ground of urgent needs of the country. In his recall message, the President, it is believed, will cite unfinished legislation and severely arraign the Congress for neglect of duty. The necessity of perfecting railroad legislation, it is said, may be the specific reason for the recall message and in addition, there will be mention of tax revision, proposed but unacted laws to control the high cost of living, rehabilitation of disabled soldiers and possibly the peace treaty.

PASS MOVIE CENSOR BILL. BOSTON, June 2.—A bill providing for a motion picture censor in Massachusetts was enacted by the Senate yesterday and was sent to Governor Coolidge for his signature.
