MAHONEY FACTION THREATENS TO SUE

Democratic Central Committee Charged With Gross Irregularities in Primaries Here.

Denying that the progressive Democratic ticket is anti-Wilson, William V. Mahoney, secretary of the Bryan Democracy Club of the District, issued a statement today, in which he asserts that the rules of the Democratic central committee were violated by failure to announce the polling places ten days before the election. "The rules of the central committee provide that ten days notice must be given for the announcement of the location of the polling places before the primary election can be held," the statement reads. "As the polling places were only announced this morning, this ruled the central committee has been violated. This delay had been occasioned on purpose to embarrass the progressive and reform forces that are behind the progressive Democratic ticket. This primary election, as a matter of fact, is not legal, as the rules only permit a calling of a convention in the District of Columbia. "An intimation came to us that the Administration or the White House wanted us to include the names of Bainbridge Colby and T. Ansbury. We yielded to this indirect suggestion and asked the Democratic Central Committee of the District to put their names on our ticket. They, however, declined to do so at 2:30 p. m. on Monday, and as the lists closed at 3 p. m. sharp, it was impossible for us to secure two other candidates in time. This ticket is not anti-Wilson. ANOTHER COURT RULES AGAINST PROFITEER LAW

Further it is held in violation of the Sixth Amendment to the Constitution guaranteeing a defendant full information of the nature of the charge against him.
