

REPRIEVES GRANTED TWO DUE TO BE HANGED TODAY

Two Others Must Go to Gallows in Chicago.

CHICAGO, Oct. 14.—Only two out of the eight men originally sentenced to be hanged in Cook county today will die on the gallows at the appointed hour as the result of two eleventh-hour reprieves granted by

Governor Lowden. The others have been saved by reprieves, commutations or writs of superseades. The latest reprieves granted were to Arthur Haensel, convicted of wife murder, and Nicholas Vinta, sentenced for the murder of a saloonkeeper. The two to face the executioner this morning are John Henry Reese, negro, convicted of wife murder, and Frank Campione, found guilty of killing a saloonkeeper. Vinta and Haensel, who received reprieves yesterday, will be hanged November 19 unless further action is taken by Governor Lowden.

Fake Marine Hero Is Drawing U. S. Pay and Adorning D. C. Hotels

PHILADELPHIA, Pa., Oct. 14.—The Philadelphia Inquirer prints the following story under a Washington date line:
Capt. Edmund G. Chamberlain, United States marine corps, aviation branch, sentenced to dismissal before court-martial in Europe nearly a year and a half ago, is still drawing full pay appearing about Washington in his nobby uniform and even telling young ladies here that he has been completely exonerated.
Captain Chamberlain was detained in Washington for several months "in arrest" before Secretary of the Navy Daniels had an opportunity to review his case. Former Attorney General Gregory, of Texas, appeared as counsel for the young man, who hails from San Antonio, and presented a strong brief pointing out alleged errors of the trial court. The case was reviewed formally before it went to Mr. Daniels for his action.
After a careful perusal of voluminous records Mr. Daniels approved the findings of the court.
It was necessary then for the case to go to President Wilson, who is required to pass finally upon all court-martial sentences involving dismissal from the service. The case has been at the White House since last December. During a good deal of the time, of course, the President's health has not been good. Knowing that Mr. Chamberlain comes from a well-known family and that there are some elements of doubt in the case the President apparently desires to review the voluminous records in person and has not yet had an opportunity to do so.
In addition to having secured the services of former Attorney General Gregory as counsel, it is understood that the father of young Chamberlain interested Col. E. M. House, long his close friend, in the case.
The fact that Captain Chamberlain is still wearing the uniform of an officer of the Marine Corps and drawing substantially \$300 a month, for which he is required to do nothing, probably would have escaped public attention had not the captain made the mistake of telling the wrong young woman that he had been completely exonerated.
This young woman happened to be the daughter of a narmy officer of considerable rank. She spoke to her father about having met Captain Chamberlain and was promptly advised that a court-martial had sentenced the Marine Corps flier to dismissal and told not to recognize him again. The daughter demurred, declaring Captain Chamberlain had told her he had been exonerated. About that time, her daddy sat down and penned a note to Chamberlain that he is not likely to forget in a long time.
The court found him guilty of having knowingly transmitted to Capt. Frank T. Evans, U. S. N., a false report of his exploits on July 27 and 28, 1918, while a visitor at a British aerodrome in the vicinity of Ploemes, France.
