Even Angels Shake a 'Mean Leg,' Says Court In Defense of Dance

"Dancing is a joy. It is a necessity of life. It promotes grace, charm, confidence, and health. If those ministers of the gospel who think dancing wicked would come out of their dark corners and dance themselves, the world would be a much brighter place to live in."

These are those ministers, who divided the congregation of the Flatbush Christian Church, causing the resignation of the pastor by their insistence that dancing is wicked, set upon by Rudolph de Zapp, president of the French Club, and co-pastor Mr. Zapp is the third prominent Washingtonian to join in the discussion on dancing, now interesting Washington moralists, as the result of the split-up in the little church at Flatbush, Brooklyn, N. Y.

CALLS 'EM FOGIES.
"In these modern times one would think such a question were absurd," said Mrs. G. H. Powell, vice president of the Girl's Friendly Society, on entering the discussion. "But evidently there are some 'fogies' who don't think so."

"Dancing is wicked," declared Elder Williamson, of the Flatbush Christian Church, who started all the trouble. "It is one of the modern evils."
"Nothing of the kind," said Pastor Frederick Marsh Gordon, in defense of the young folks of the congregation, and the result was that the board requested the four elders to resign. The Rev. Gordon then handed in his resignation. The question was too much for Flatbush and now Washington moralists and patrons of the arts are trying their hand at it.

URGES DANCE CENSORS.
"Since dancing has been called a modern evil let us solve the dance problem in the most sensible way by providing the proper supervision at the dance halls," said Mrs. Powell.
"More municipal dance halls with proper chaperonage will solve the dance problem," said Judge Kathryn Sellers, of the Juvenile Court, agreeing with Mrs. Powell.

Let us teach dancing in the public schools," said Mr. de Zapp. "That would be my solution. The public must be taught that dancing is an art. It must learn to view this aesthetic subject from an ethical standpoint. Dancing is a great physical exercise. If dancing were wicked do you think it would be cultivated by West Point, and the Naval Academy. Yet dancing is taught as part of the curriculum at these great institutions. Moreover to those ministers of the gospel, who think it wicked, I would recommend that they read their Bibles more carefully. One reference to angels dancing is what I have especially in mind."

SENATE TO TAKE UP SOLDIER LAND PLAN

Smoot Committee Is Believed Favorably Inclined Toward Settlement Scheme.

The Senate Public Lands Committee, of which Senator Reed Smoot is chairman, is expected to give serious attention to land settlement and kindred bills for soldiers as soon as the session of Congress opens. The committee had the question up at the close of last session and was favorably inclined toward legislation. Senator Borah has a new plan which he will introduce in December and which already meets with much favor from the members of the Public Lands Committee.

It carries an appropriation of \$300,000,000, to be utilized to aid veterans in purchasing farms or homes or in settling reclaimed lands. One of the difficulties in the way of land settlement legislation or anything similar to it is the objection of the older agricultural States to developing the irrigable areas of the far West or the swamp lands and 'outover' lands of the South at Government expense. The older agricultural areas calculate this would affect them adversely.
