AUTOMATIC DRAFT LAW, AIM OF KAHN

House Military Committee Chief Also Will Press Universal Training Bill.

The movement for universal training is far from being halted, in spite of the opposition to it in some quarters. Congressman Julius Kahn, chairman of the House Military Committee, long an advocate of the benefits of universal training, intends to make an effort to get Congress to take it up this winter. Aside from universal training, he will advocate an automatic draft law, to make conscription effective at once on the declaration of war. "In the recent war, we lost at least three months' time in passing the draft law and putting it into effect," said Congressman Kahn. "While we lost this time, the allies were holding the lines and keeping the enemy back. Another time, there might be no allies to hold back the enemy lines, and

three months' time might cost us the war. It would be much better to have the draft become operative automatically should war break out." It is not generally believed that Congress will enact any universal training legislation. The opposition throughout the country to this policy is strong. Nevertheless, Mr. Kahn does not purpose to let the movement die out. There is going to be a strong effort made to cut down the military and naval forces. Some members will urge this as a necessary step toward economy. The opposition will take the stand that with war clouds lowering over much of Europe and with the Oriental situation far from reassuring, this is no time to reduce forces.
