**'VILLA' REPRIEVED;
WON'T HANG MAR. 25**

Gov. Ritchie Grants Convicted Slayer 21 Days' Reprieve Pending Appeal.

Guy Vernon ("Villa") Thompson, convicted of the slaying of James Bolton and two children at Germantown, Montgomery county, will not hang on the gallows at Rockville on March 25 as sentenced by Chief Judge Urner, of the circuit court of Montgomery county. On the petition of John A. Garrett, Thompson's lawyer, the court has granted a reprieve until April 15. Garrett has indicated he intends to appeal the case to the Maryland court of appeals.

Discovering that March 25, the date set for the execution of Robert Robinson, colored, sentenced to die for the slaying of James Elder Tydings in Anne Arundel county, Md., is Good Friday, Governor Ritchie yesterday postponed the date for Robinson's hanging to April 1.
