SPEND 16 P. C. OF SALARY FOR CLOTHES, IS ADVICE

Home Economist Gives Figures for Ideal Family Budget.

LAWRENCE, Kan., March 17.—The "ideal" family budget, for clothing a family of five, is approximately 16 per cent of the yearly income, according to tests made by students of the home economics department of the University of Kansas. This is possible, however, the students declare only when the housewife makes her own dresses, the children's clothing and the husband's shirts and pajamas.

The "16 per cent" provides for every bit of clothing for all members of the family. The "economics" experts assert that it should be sufficient if the housewife does her own sewing and the younger children wear the discarded apparel of the older ones.

Here are some figures submitted by the students in regard to the budget.

A family of five with an income of \$2,400 should not spend more than \$384 a year for clothes, dividing the amount in this manner: Man, \$118.40; woman, \$102.30; boy of nine years, \$41.06; girl of six years, \$38.78; girl of three years, \$33.72.

The leaves a balance of \$41.74 for incidentals such as collar buttons, hairpins and thread.

DR. FRANK GUNSAULUS SUCCUMBS IN CHICAGO

CHICAGO, March 17.—Dr. Frank Gunsaulus, president and one of the founders of the Armour Institute of Technology, and one of the most noted ministers of the present day, died here at 4 o'clock this morning. The end came two hours after he had been stricken with heart disease.

Dr. Gunsaulus was pastor of Central Church here for twenty years, and was internationally known as a minister and lecturer. He resigned his pastorate several years ago to give all of his time to the Armour Institute.
