**WOMAN LOSES APPEAL IN SUIT WITH RAILROAD**  
The Chesapeake & Ohio Railroad Company has won in the Supreme Court of the United States its case against Sarah Mary Wall, who claimed damages for the death of her husband in Ohio.  
The woman brought suit in Illinois for \$10,000 damages from the Chesapeake & Railroad for the killing of her husband. While the suit was pending the Illinois legislature passed a law prohibiting legal action in the State for injuries sustained outside the State. Well had been killed at Cincinnati.  
The Illinois court dismissed the suit and Sarah Mary Wall appealed to the United States Supreme Court.
