SIX VESSELS BRING RELIEF TO WARSAW

Distribution of Supplies is Hampered by Traffic Trouble and Labor Problems.

WARSAW, April 14.—Six steamships containing 10,000 tons of American food supplies in addition to quantities of medical and relief supplies have arrived in Danzig. These are the first large shipments in bulk of American supplies to reach Poland since her period of greatest need began. Five additional steamers are expected in Danzig shortly.

At American food corps headquarters the complaint has been made that great delay was being experienced in getting the cargoes from Danzig to Warsaw.

USE TONS OF SUPPLIES.
The Salaam brought twenty-six tons of medicinal supplies, which were sorely needed in the work here, but which, so far, have not been received. Delays in unloading are almost invariably on account of labor troubles in Danzig. After this the overburdened condition of the traffic between here and Danzig makes shipment a slow process. Shortage of rolling stock is now making the provisioning of Warsaw a matter of particularly great difficulty.

Polish newspapers here have given much space to the news of the arrival of these shipments, describing each cargo as it arrives in detail. The steamers that have been reported so far are the West Zede, Salaam, Dan-

zig, Cornelia, Weichsel and the Ratum. The cargoes consist principally of grain and flour, together with 2,000 tons of condensed milk and 400 tons of cocoa. The entire cargoes are consigned to various American relief organizations.

The statement of the Polish ministry of appropriation covering its activities for the year 1920, made public here today, furnishes a lucid explanation of the reason why foreign aid in solving the problem of food supply for Poland is absolutely indispensable.

PROGRAM OF RATIONING.
The scant program of rationing which the ministry originally framed for the year 1920-21 called for a minimum crop of cereals, to be delivered by the farmers of Poland to the ministry for distribution, expressed as 27,000 railway carloads. Last fall, after the Bolshevik invasion, when it was seen that the crop would not reach 15 distributable carloads, the ministry reduced its program of rationing, cutting down the quantity of bread and debasing it still further in quality, as well as making similar changes regarding other foodstuffs.

The ministry, in its detailed statement, now shows that the crop actually garnered was less than half the amount originally estimated. It was in fact about 12,125 carloads. M. Silyniewski, the minister of appropriation, declares that had it not been necessary to abandon his policy of rationing altogether, the quantity of foodstuffs that would have been sufficient to maintain life.

Paper Mill Starts Up Again.
WELLSBURG, W. Va., April 14.—The S. George paper mill, one of the principal industries of Wellsburg, has resumed operations. According to Treasurer I. B. George, the company has enough orders on hand to run two months.
