**CHARGED \$199 FOR SCIENTIFIC KISSES**

**Woman Testifies Against Incomparable Psychiatrist and Clairvoyant at Trial.**  
LOS ANGELES, May 17.—For illustrating what constitutes a scientific kiss, a fair-seeker after advice paid \$199, according to testimony before the members of the board of county supervisors.  
Scientific kissing came within the supervisors' jurisdiction when they listened to testimony by a number of witnesses in the case of James A. Murdock, who advertises as being the "incomparable psychiatrist and clairvoyant."

**GIVEN KISSING TREATMENT.**  
Mrs. Sarah Blackburn and her daughter, "Billie," aged seventeen, the latter of whom it was testified, had been given the demonstration lesson by Murdock in the science of kissing, appeared against Murdock. Mrs. Blackburn said one of Murdock's clairvoyant "tips" told her her daughter was concealing things from her. As a result Murdock advised her to bring "Billie" to him, where he would admonish the girl and place her feet "back upon the path of frankness."

According to Mrs. Blackburn, "Billie" was taken to the "incomparable one" for a treatment. The girl was called to tell her experiences with the "psychiatrist." She said Murdock insisted on her being in a room alone with him.

**PAID HIM \$199.**  
It was at this juncture, said the witness, that scientific kissing was demonstrated. Murdock prefacing the act by a dissertation on the effect of kissing on the brain in developing dormant faculties.  
For all this advice given the Blackburns, mother and daughter, Mrs. Blackburn said she paid Murdock \$199. Murdock, appearing half-way between fifty and sixty and inclined to an abundance of weight, said "lots" of people came to him for advice in business matters and other interests.

**LEGION INDORSED ON RELIEF STAND**

**Demand for Prompt Aid to Disabled Sweeps Country, Officials Say.**

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., May 17.—Immediate relief for disabled veterans of the world war is demanded by hundreds of resolutions coming into national headquarters of the American Legion here from all parts of the country. During the week ended May 7 more than 500 resolutions, calling for prompt legislative aid from Congress and signed by civic, commercial, religious, patriotic, and fraternal organizations have been received in response to an appeal made by F. W. Galbraith, jr., national commander of the legion.  
Chambers of commerce in forty-two cities from Maine to Texas mailed resolutions. Governor McKelvie, of Nebraska, was among the public officials who approved the legion program for beneficial legislation. One resolution bears the seal of the city of Paducah, Ky., and it is signed by the mayor and city clerk. The Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen, the United Mine Workers of America, and the Railway Mail Association, three of the largest and most influential labor organizations in the world, also subscribed to the legion's program. The Kiwanis, Rotary, and Lions clubs; Knights of Columbus, Y. M. C. A., and League of Women Voters replied from hundreds of local units broadcast over the country. Not one reply unfavorable to the legion's legislative stand has been received.

**SLEEPING BABY FOUND ABANDONED IN BARREL**

NEW YORK, May 17.—In a dry barrel half filled with fastidious and other trash of a florist's shop at the Hamilton Parkway and Dahill street, Brooklyn, Isidore Landman early yesterday found a human bloom, a little baby girl, about two weeks old.  
The child was alive, apparently comfortable, and contentedly sleeping. She was neatly clothed and wrapped in a warm blue and white blanket. A policeman of the Parkville station took the infant to the Kings County Hospital. Nothing to hint the identity of the parents was found with the child.

**A. F. IN G. MEANS ALLEN'S FAMILY, SAY RHINE VETS**

COBLENZ, May 17.—Somebody asked one of the soldiers of the American army on the Rhine what they meant by referring to their organization as the "A. F. in G." He replied: It means "American Forces in Germany," but doughboys call it "Allen's family in Germany."  
The reply is indicative of the relations between General Allen, the American commander, and his troops.

**WAGES CUT IN SWEDEN AS EMPLOYEES RESIST**

STOCKHOLM, May 17.—An effort to reduce wages and cost of production to the present lower level of prices is being resisted. Swedish wage earners generally, but a start has been made in the wood pulp and cellulose industry, where wages have been lowered 15 per cent.  
One of the largest electrical companies has also come to an argument with its operatives for an adjustment to a lower rate.

**ARCHDUKE ESCAPES MOB WHEN PALACE IS STONED**

VIENNA, May 17.—Archduke Rainer of Hapsburg was the recipient of unpleasant attentions on the part of workmen when his presence in the palace at Hertenstein, near Vienna, became known. Stones were thrown through the windows and his expulsion was demanded of the authorities. Meanwhile, the archduke made his escape disguised as a workman.
