POCK-FACED MAN HELD AS SUSPECT IN WEBER KILLING


Mysterious White Man With Sunken Eyes Caught on Farm Early Today.

Captured on a farm early this morning, armed with a revolver and with powder marks on his face, a white man, suspected of having some connection with the slaying on May 19 last of Mrs. Margaret E. Weber, twenty-year-old bride at White Station, Prince Georges county, today is being held for investigation at the jail at Leesburg, Va.

HELD FOR IDENTIFICATION.

Deputy Sheriff J. D. Lambert, Jr., of Leesburg, who headed the posse which arrested the man, said to have formerly been a resident of Georgetown, told The Times that he believed the suspect was the white man with the "sunken eyes and cheek" who was seen in the strip of woodland an hour after Mrs. Weber was assaulted and shot to death.
