CAROLINA JURY TO INVESTIGATE KU KLUX KLAN

Inquiry Follows Tales of Two Women, Who Allege They Were Mistreated.

ASHEVILLE, N. C., Nov. 10.—Grand jury investigation of alleged activities of the Ku Klux Klan has been ordered by Judge Walter E. Brock, of the Superior Court, following a statement in open court by attorneys for two women defendants that the women were ordered from their bed at Saluda, fifty miles south of here, early in the morning and brought back to Asheville by unidentified men.

Released on Bail. Following the arrest of the women on warrants naming statutory charges, they gave a bond of \$400 each as required by a magistrate and left town. At Saluda they stopped for the night and about 4 o'clock in the morning were awakened by four men. One of the men was Deputy Sheriff Trotter, of Polk county, before whom the three unidentified men had appeared, telling the deputy they had a warrant for the women and asking his aid.

Women Found Guilty. Louis Heney, negro, involved in the case, gave bond for \$1,000 and has fled the state, according to his attorney. Eugene Garlington, the other negro, was remanded to jail in default of bond.

CHINA TO FIGHT FOR EXISTENCE, DELEGATE SAYS

People Aroused to Menace of Foes Within and Without, Dr. Chiang Declares.

"The people of China are thoroughly awakened to the fact that they must rise and fight for their very national existence against all foes, both within and without," Dr. Monlin Chiang, one of China's two unofficial delegates to the armament and Far East conference, declared today.

Dr. Chiang, who is dean of administration of the National University in Peking, and David Z. T. Yui, general secretary of the Central Y. M. C. A. of China, who were sent by the people of the whole of China to watch the progress of the conference, arrived today.

Dr. Chiang said China is split into three factions, all fighting for supremacy. They are the Chang Tao-lin group in north China; the Wu Pei-fu faction in central China, and the south China republic with headquarters in Canton. Dr. Sun Yat-sen, first provisional president of China, is head of the Cantonese government.

The Washington postoffice today received its quota of "Mail Early" placards for holiday use. Enough of the cards were given for use on all mail wagons and automobiles and for display in larger stores. The cards are now being sent out to all first, second and third class offices.

24 NEW WITNESSES TO AID ARBUCKLE'S DEFENSE

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., Nov. 10.—Milton Cohen, personal attorney for Roscoe "Fatty" Arbuckle, was in Los Angeles today armed with twenty-five subpoenas with which to summon witnesses for the defense of the film star when he goes on trial next week for manslaughter. Thirteen of the twenty-five witnesses are named in the subpoenas and twelve were blank.

FRENCH UNIFORMS RELIEVE SOMBERNESS OF DELEGATES

The French delegation to the armament conference affords the only note of color in the otherwise somber gathering of statesmen here. The horizon blue uniforms and the scarlet caps of the French military leaders vie with the latest Parisian frocks of a galaxy of girl telephonists, secretaries, typists and stenographers who accompanied the French party.
