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The Virginia Conservative Convention.

THE VIRGINIA CONSERVATIVE CONVENTION. The Convention adjourned—They Want a Conservative Government.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 13.—The Virginia Conservative Convention met this morning. The committee reported the following resolutions, which were unanimously adopted.

1st. They recognize that by the result of war slavery has been abolished, and it is not the desire of the people of Virginia to re-enslave a people who have been emancipated by the events of the war, and by an amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

2d. They assert the right of Virginia to restore to the Union, and to perform her duties to the Union.

3d. They protest against the government in any way not defined in the Federal Constitution.

4th. This resolution adopts the language adopted at Cooper Institute, New York, in 1850, and declares that the government of the United States is a government of the people, and that the people are entitled to the right of self-government.
