ANNIVERSARY SERMON.—Yesterday morning the services in the Third Presbyterian church in this city, were of more than ordinary interest—the day being the fifth anniversary of the installation of Rev. J. Cross as pastor of the charge. After the usual preliminary exercises, Mr. C. announced as his text, "Watchman, what of the night?"—Isaiah 21: 11. The duties of a watchman having been briefly stated, Mr. C. continued substantially as follows: Five years ago I came here by the invitation of S. O. Ziegler, on a visit, not knowing that there was a Presbyterian church here. When I arrived he told me they had a church which had been closed for some time, and they were about to give up the enterprise, and he wanted me to preach in it on Sabbath. Notices were put up, and on Sabbath morning thirty persons were present. I preached eight days, and over thirty converts to religion. I was urged to take charge as pastor of the flock. This I did with fear and trembling. There was only thirty members on the roll and all these could not be found. There have been 158 members added to the church in five years. We have had nineteen communions, and never had less than two additions, nor more than eighteen at a time. The growth has been regular. Of those we have now on our roll 124 members, seven have died in the faith, five have been suspended, and fifty-one have been dismissed to other churches. Our general attendance is good on all our services, and the order and decorum of the congregation excellent. Our harmony and brotherly love have been uninterupted. The failure of some of our large manufacturing interests, and the want of employment has driven many of our people away. In consequence of this more than one-third of our members have left, and near a third of our financial support has been cut off. We have over 300 youth and children in the Sabbath school, and so far as your pastor can see, there is nothing to discourage, except the floating character of our population. The foregoing is but the briefest abstract of the statistical portion of Mr. C.'s sermon. The attendance was quite large, and the venerable minister had the undivided attention of his auditors. An earnest appeal to the membership to work and pray for the salvation of perishing souls was made at the close of this interesting discourse, which we do not believe will soon be forgotten by those who heard it. The relations subsisting between Rev. Mr. C. and his congregation are of the most pleasant character.
