A WHALE.

Mr. E. JACOB, of Waynesville, Ohio, who went to San Domingo with the U. S. Commission as correspondent of the Cincinnati Commercial and went back on his own account last winter, has furnished the Commercial the following sketch of the cutting up of a whale captured in Samana Bay:
