General Howard's Bond not to be Found. WASHINGTON, July 2.—The Attorney General, in the preparation of his opinion as to the responsibility of Gen. Howard, Commissioner of the Freedmen's Bureau, for the acts of his subordinates, called upon the First Comptroller of the Treasury for a copy of the bond of \$50,000 which a law of 1865 directed should be given by the Commissioner for the faithful performance of his duties.
