Boiling the Ticket. The Fairmont ticket to us with a well executed out of a fat, sleek, rampant Democratic rooster, from whose beak a scroll dangles to the breeze over the crest and tail of the noble bird, bearing this bull of excommunication, viz: "Death to All Voters!" To a true blue Bourbon Democrat, whose principal family tradition is that neither he nor his father before him ever scratched the regular Democratic ticket, the idea of boiling the party nomination is like the sin of bery in the eyes of an ultramontane. It is something so heinous in its nature that the severest penances can alone atone for it. And yet all reading, thinking, free minded people know that this world would be practically a failure, both in religion and politics, were it not for heresy. Heretics are the people who, braving partisan opinion, dare to form and express opinions of their own, instead of embracing those ready made for them. They have always been denounced and severely dealt with. Many of the grandest truths in both politics and science were once esteemed rank heresies. The celebrated St. Simon was at one time arraigned for saying that the Bourbons were made for France and not France for the Bourbons. Such men as St. Simon were "boilers" from the regular ticket in their day. The same principle that actuated those who arraigned them now actuates the modern Bourbons who deal out impotent threats of political death to those who dare refuse to subscribe to their caudal proceedings. The threat of the Index will do for party slaves and hangers on, and will intimidate such, but it is an insult and nothing else to a freeman, and will be so regarded and treated by all those at whom it is aimed if they have the spirit of freemen within them.

One of the wholesome signs of the times is the fact that "boiling" is becoming quite common. The schools and the newspapers are too much for rings and cliques. A man to whom Providence has given sufficient capacity to think for himself, and who has enjoyed opportunities for information, cannot be made a mere machine in politics. He is not a Wetzel county, automatic voter. He can give a reason for his faith. The hope of the country is in this element. The greater the disposition to bolt the more certainly will bolting be rendered unnecessary. Once political parties get to understand that their nominees will be freely scratched or bolted, if not acceptable to the public, a great deal more care will be taken in nominating them.

This March Chunk (Pa.) Democrat has the following regarding the condition of the iron trade: "There is no use disguising the fact that the iron business is not improving. If anything the trade is duller than it was six months ago. Of the 507 furnace stacks in the United States only 318 are in blast, while 227 are out of blast. In the Lehigh region out of 50 stacks 27 are in blast, with 23 out. In the Schuylkill region 32 out of 44 stacks are in blast. In the upper Susquehanna 9 out of 15 and lower Susquehanna 21 out of 29 are in blast. We believe ourselves to be safely within the limits of the truth when we say that not nine out of every ten manufacturing institutions in the Lehigh Valley are working with anything like a profit, while many are barely making ends meet, and would close down altogether but out of consideration for their employees."

As iron works in Leeburg, Pennsylvania, turn out weekly about seventy tons of sheet iron by the use for fuel of natural gas drawn from an abandoned oil well situated about one-fifth of a mile from the works. The production has been increased about thirty-three per cent. since the gas was first used, about seven months ago. The iron made by the use of gas commands from \$10 to \$20 per ton more than the same class of iron made by the same firm at other works where coal is used for fuel. This natural flow of gas is plentiful in that region, and along the Ohio river it is utilized in many ways for heating, lighting and in manufacturing establishments.

The Capital Question. [From the Wheeling (Grant Co.) Examiner.] The next Legislature will be composed of members fresh from the people, and it behooves them to look well to the interests of their constituents. There can be no excuse for ignorance as to the true sentiment of the people on the much vexed question of the removal of the Capital of the State from Charleston. The matter has been long and most urgently agitated throughout the State, and a large majority of the business men of West Virginia have spoken out boldly in favor of a more eligible site for the seat of government. Why should it be continued at Charleston? There is no earthly reason for it. On the contrary, it is of the utmost importance that it should be removed, and temporarily located where the people of the State cannot only reach it in person, but hear what their public servants are doing.

For the last three years Legislatures have convened at Charleston, and passed laws for the government of the State, and arranged the wheels of government in order to keep the machine in motion. But the people were ignorant of all this until several weeks, and sometimes months had elapsed. This is all wrong. The people take an interest in electing members of the Legislature—both of the House and Senate, and it is but justice that they be informed of what they do, and that too without delay. From our own observations we know that the people of this section favor removal. Let Wheeling, Parkersburg, Clarksburg or Grafton be the point, we are not particular which, so that we can reach it without traversing the globe, or get a business letter there without waiting two months for a reply. The people of Wheeling offered superior inducements to have the Capital retained there, and there it should have remained. Under present circumstances it is yet the best point in the State. Members will find good accommodation, and they will feel more like attending to their legitimate business than they will in the little muddy village of Charleston.
