EARLY SHEEP-GROWING IN THIS REGION.

Ohio County, April 28 1876.

It is believed that the first man to introduce fine wool sheep into Ohio county, and perhaps all this region was N. P. Atkinson. He was a Massachusetts boy, but was doing quite a profitable business in Montreal, Canada, when the war of 1812 broke out between this country and England.

Mr. Atkinson was one of the most intelligent farmers Ohio county has ever had. The Vermont farmers, observing that manufacturers made but little difference in price between light, clean wool and greasy wool, introduced the Spanish breed and bred them, with a view of increasing the quantity of grease, until their flock looked like they had been smothered in petroleum.
