BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. The Board of County Commissioners met at a special meeting at the Court House yesterday morning. All the members were present except Mr. Handlan. The minutes were read and approved, after which the

COMMITTEE ON FINANCE submitted a report containing certain recommendations in regard to erroneous assessments; also recommending the payment of bill of E. General, \$75, for the late term of the County Court. In regard to the severe damage occurring to the Fulton bridge, the committee reported that they had contracted with the builder for immediate repairs, as per bill of \$235, allowing the county \$30 for the old iron, and making the net cost of the repairs \$205. The report was adopted.

COURT HOUSE AND JAIL. This committee recommended the payment of bills aggregating \$135 08. The committee made an examination of the jail and the contents of the cells, and found the building kept in as good condition as the age of the property will admit. Some cells require to be wadded, and the committee recommended that the Sheriff be instructed to make frequent use of copra and other disinfectants in and about the cells, and to have a full supply of lime used on the cells that are not whitewashed. The report was adopted.

THE COUNTY ROAD. W. C. Smith, the General Superintendent of Roads, reported that during the month but little work had been done on public improvements. The portion of the road between the bridge at Steensrod's, and forcing it against the south span of the county bridge at Fulton, inflicted very serious injury upon the latter structure and entirely destroyed the wooden bridge. The repairs of the injured span were completed, and as soon as possible, by the Finance Committee the Canton Company, who were the original contractors, undertaking to restore the bridge to its original condition for the sum of \$666 net.

DEATH OF DR. JOHN G. APFELCO. Dr. John G. Apfelco, one of the oldest and most prominent physicians in this city, died at his residence in this place yesterday morning at 12:30 o'clock, aged seventy-five years.
