A New York special to the St. Louis Republic says: James H. Eads, in a letter published here to-day, outlines his plan for a railroad across the Isthmus of Darien for carrying ships. He argues against a canal on the ground of expense and timidity. He also describes a device for raising ships from the water to the track without changing the ship's horizontal position.
