AMERICAN INDUSTRIES.

Manufacture and Agriculture—Our Export Trade—Internal Commerce.

Chief Nimmo arrives at some interesting general facts in his statistical explorations.

Within the memory of men of middle age the great West was dependent upon the East and upon foreign countries almost entirely for manufactured products.

Our statistical investigator shows that the value of the manufactures of the West increased from \$346,678,200 in 1860 to \$1,683,000 in 1880.

During the latter, the value of the products of manufacture of the Western and Northern States was 50 per cent greater than the total value of the products of the United States in 1860, and almost equal to the total value of the manufactures of the country in 1880.

Until the actual figures are produced, one has a very uncertain idea as to the relative productiveness of agricultural and manufacturing enterprises.

At the last census the capital employed in our manufacturing enterprises amounted to \$2,790,272,000, and the value given to materials in the process of manufacture before the actual amount, approximately to \$2,000,000,000, or 71 per cent of the capital employed.

The value of farms, including land, fences and buildings, was \$1,019,096,777, and the value of all agricultural productions during the census year was estimated at \$3,690,000,000, or about 35 per cent of the value of property in farms.

Hence the relative productiveness of capital in manufacturing and in agriculture is as 2 to 1.

These figures are given to speaking of our exports of manufactures as though they were absolutely of vital importance, but the actual figures indicate that this view is considerable of a mistake.

The products of our manufactures in 1880 were worth \$5,269,579,193, of which only \$1,000,000,000, or 2 per cent, was exported.

The balance became the subject of internal commerce and was consumed at home.

Speaking of internal commerce, indeed manufactures now constitute the most important element of the trade of our large towns and city.

The property of even New York city—the great commercial entrepot of the country—at which point 77 per cent of our foreign commerce is carried on, is a more highly dependent upon manufacturing industries than upon foreign commerce.

During the year ending June 30, 1880, the value of the total foreign commerce at that city amounted to \$552,497,345, the value of exports amounting to \$392,500,000, and that of imports to \$160,997,345.

The total value of the manufactures of the city, however, during the census year, amounted to \$172,929,437, and those of Brooklyn to \$172,225,142, the value of exports commercially one city—being \$950,149,579.

But the manufacture and sale of every dollar's worth of products of manufacture probably contributed ten times as much toward the employment of labor as the sustenance of people in these cities as did every dollar's worth of foreign goods imported.

The manufacturing industries of the two cities involved not only the wages paid for the manufacture of goods, but also wages paid for transport and delivering finished products.

They also required the use of and rental upon a large amount of property in the manufacture and storage of merchandise.

Besides, they gave rise to the purchase and sale of raw materials and of finished products.

On the other hand, immense portions of the foreign exports of New York city paid the people of the city little more than the expenses of trans-shipment and warehousing.
