The Animals Strayed Up. The Mugwump newspapers, and some also of the pure Democratic strain, don't entirely like the Senate's reply to the President on the rejection of Matthews.

RAILROAD PRIVILEGES.

What the Davis Road Asks—How a Similar Franchise Worked in Old Virginia. To the Editor of the Intelligencer. Sir:—You referred to-day with just comments of caution to the proposed charter Mr. Davis is asking for his railroad. There was one such charter granted at an early day in Virginia. It was the Richmond and Fredericksburg railroad. It became a great monopoly. It laid all the travel and freight from Washington to Richmond over the Orange Alexandria railroad tributary, to it by laying a heavy subsidy on that road. But was brought to the right of the Legislature in disposing of the eminent domain of the State by giving exclusive right to a railroad.

A majority of the Supreme Court of Virginia decided in favor of the Fredericksburg charter. Judge George H. Lee dissented, and gave his dissenting opinion of the court. He held rightly that the Legislature had no such right over the eminent domain of the State as to give the exclusive right to any company to build a road any place in the State. There can be no doubt at this day that a Legislature has no right over the eminent domain further than to grant a charter to a railroad company to build a road from one point to another.

It cannot be possible that this Legislature can bar future Legislatures from granting such charters as they may desire for building a railroad any place a company may desire. But a majority of the Court of Appeals of Virginia once decided differently. What has been done may be done again. So continuing to grant the Legislature not to grant this Davis charter any exclusive privilege.

An English Opinion of the Claims of Canada. The London correspondent of the Darwin News, a newspaper published in the great cotton manufacturing county of Lancashire, England, writes, to that paper as follows: The United States fisheries dispute has entered an acute stage. We have heard a great deal of sentimental twaddle lately about Imperial Federation. This is just one of the things people are saying, to put a pin in the windbag of Imperial Federation. If Canada had not the right to appeal to the fisheries dispute would never have developed into such proportions. A friendly chat by two or three men of each country "round a table" would have settled the matter long ago.
