Those Joint Discussions. It is not to be supposed that Chairman Riley of the Democratic State Committee intended to treat Chairman Cowden of the Republican Committee with discourtesy.

Another is that the Democratic Committee repented of its bargain, wanted to extricate itself, did not wish Mr. Wilson to meet General Goff, and so thoughtily declared that it would take just about its own time to arrange the dates.

What the Democratic Committee should have done, in fairness to the other side, was to say frankly that for reasons of its own it would like to have the whole matter of joint discussion declared off.

Is the Tariff Eating Up the Farmers? A reader of the INTELLIGENCER says he has seen the statement that the mortgages on the farms of this country aggregate 3,000 million dollars, and he would like to know whether this is true.

There are now about five million owners of farms. A million of these have been acquired since 1880. Many of the four millions then in cultivation have since changed hands.

Among the various objects of criticism which were made in the columns of the INTELLIGENCER were several very positive assertions that the Western farmers in this country were generally bankrupt, or were losing money, especially on wheat and corn.

All which seriously impairs the farm mortgage argument of the Free Traders. So it is with all of their arguments. They can't stand the cold test of the solid facts.
