It is believed they will not finish their work before the end of next week. One of the witnesses was an official of the Postal Telegraph Company, but the nature of his testimony is not known.

Some sensation was created when Thomas G. Windes, Alexander Sullivan's partner, mounted the steps and declared the grand jury names.

Mr. Windes was retained by the jury for nearly an hour, and great speculation was indulged in as to the nature of his testimony.

It finally transpired that Mr. Windes had been questioned minutely as to his information regarding Sullivan's speculations on the Board of Trade, and whether the money used by the Irish leaders was the funds of the Clan-na-Gael organization.

The witness knew nothing regarding Sullivan's private speculations, and was unable to give the jury any valuable information.

ON THE RACK.

Dan Brown, the Stanton avenue officer, who preferred the charges of treason against Cronin, for which the latter was tried and expelled from the Clan-na-Gael, was subjected to a most rigorous examination as to the details of the working of the Clan-na-Gael or United Brotherhood, and required to give his reasons for having originally suspected Cronin of treason to the cause.
