It is noteworthy that with two exceptions every county in Pennsylvania on the northern border went for the prohibitory amendment, and that with two exceptions every county on the southern border went against the amendment.

Prohibitionists rejoiced with reason three years ago over the adoption of constitutional prohibition by Rhode Island. After three years of very unsatisfactory experience Rhode Island repels the amendment by a much larger majority than she gave for its adoption.

This radical change in public sentiment means something. It could no more have been brought by the liquor men than they could have produced with money the anti-prohibition tidal wave in Pennsylvania.

The action of Rhode Island in throwing overboard prohibition is even more of a blow to that cause than the surprising adverse vote of Pennsylvania. Plainly prohibition is not on the up grade.

The President and the Patriotic Sons. The Patriotic Sons of America do not agree with the Democratic press that there was a flavor of Burchardism in the President's refusal to wear the badge of the order. Through their press committee they say:

The badge incident so sensationally characterized as a "Burchardism" is a misrepresentation. The reception by the President was cordial and gratifying to the members of this order, and the fact that he has promised to wear the badge on Friday is evidence that no ill-feeling has been generated between the members of this order and our country's Chief Executive.

Simon Cameron. Simon Cameron, ninety years old, is thought to be dying. It has long been the old man's proud boast that he has not only had length of years but a full life. He has been a generous liver, and in the heat of his fiercest political campaigns has always had time and inclination to enjoy himself. Few men have wielded so great political power over so many years. Simon Cameron began his political career before men of middle age were born. He made hosts of enemies.

His friendships were the marvel of American politics; he had more of them and more ones in his own State than any man who ever lived in it. Some of the warmest of his friends were Democrats whom he had at some time obliged, and in any crisis of his political fortunes they rallied to him. They gave him services and even contributed money to his campaign fund. This was his return for standing by his friends, some times, as others thought, at the cost of his obligation to the public. Being re-elected with one and told that a certain friend of his was wrong, Cameron replied, "I know it, and that is why I am standing by him so vigorously. If he were right, everybody would stand by him." That he carried a good trait too far, goes without saying; but this was one of his qualities.

Of late years the antagonisms of his more active days have been less seen and heard of, and the old man's son has been going down peacefully and pleasantly. His death will call out from old
