PHILADELPHIA, Pa., April 28.--The destruction of the Grand Central theatre last night proves to have been more terrible in its results than was anticipated.

Six members of the "Devil's Auction" company lie dead beneath the fallen walls of the building and nearly three score of people are in the hospital.
