GILL GETS A BOOM. The Flint Glass Workers' Union Endorses Him for Congress. STUBBSVILLE, O., March 11.—The candidacy of J. J. Gill, the manufacturer and banker of this city, for the Republican nomination for Congress, received an unexpected boom to-day. One of the industries which he controls is the Acme glass works of this city, where seven hundred men are employed, and in spite of the fact that the law of the American Flint Union prohibits any political action local union No. 8, which is about evenly divided politically, and one of the strongest labor unions in this city, having in it more skilled workmen than any others, departed from the usages of the order and unanimously endorsed Mr. Gill's candidacy.
