A Fifteen-Year-Old Girl Teaches Little Girls to Pick Pockets—An Organized Band of Child Thieves Unearthed in New York. Bella Geckelman, who is fifteen years old, has snapping black eyes and raven black curls, is wanted by the police for complicity in several thefts which have occurred lately in the dry goods district around Grand street and Broadway.

Detective Savage, of the Central Park squad, arrested two of the band yesterday afternoon in the monkey house, on the complaint of a young woman, whose pocketbook was afterward found in the possession of one of the prisoners.

Fanny hardly comprehended the meaning of the proceedings, and innocently told where they had been and what her companion had done.
