

THE WHAT WANT PENSIONS. A Movement for a Teachers' Retirement fund to be Sprung at the Teachers' Association

STATE MEETING IN THIS CITY THIS MONTH—MISS CLOHAN, PRINCIPAL OF CLAY SCHOOL IN WHEELING, IS THE AUTHOR OF THE SCHEME—IT PROVIDES FOR AN ASSESSMENT UPON WORKING TEACHERS TO ACCUMULATE THE PENSION FUND.

Interest in the coming annual meeting of the West Virginia Teachers' Association in this city is general throughout the state, and the indications are that at least 500 from every section of the state will gather here. The local committees in charge of the meeting have already prepared a program which is being spread in the Intelligencer. It is promising of three days of enjoyment and instruction that no teacher can afford to miss.

Added interest is felt in the meeting because the recently inaugurated movement for a teachers' retirement fund through the working of which teachers of long service who are unable to continue in the harness are pensioned, is being championed by the principal of Clay school, the author of the scheme and she will present it at the coming meeting of the state's association. The retirement fund plan is outlined below:

NAME: West Virginia Teachers' Retirement Fund. Object: The purpose of this association shall be to provide for the relief of infirm and aged teachers of this State, who shall have been members of this association...

Officers and Administration—The administration of the business of this association shall be in the hands of a board of trustees, which shall consist of the state representative teachers of the several counties in accordance with conditions which may be hereinafter provided for in the annual program of the State Educational Association. The board of trustees shall organize by electing from their number a president, vice president and secretary, and the state treasurer shall serve as treasurer...

Membership—Membership in the association shall at first be voluntary, and no person shall be admitted as a member until the proper application to be provided. But three years after the passage of an act incorporating this association, all persons becoming teachers in the free schools of the state shall be deemed members of this association...
