AMERICAN LINE
Of Proposed Railway a Very Important Link
IN CONNECTING ALL CHINA

WASHINGTON, July 21.—The proposed American railway line in China, if existing agreements are carried out and the line constructed, prove an important link in a system connecting all of China with all of the outside world.
