

WOMAN'S NUDE BODY FOUND IN TRUNK

The Trunk Was Shipped From Detroit, Michigan, to New York City.

New York, July 24.—The body of a nude woman, jammed in a trunk was found today by employees of the American Railway Express company, among the unclaimed baggage in the company's East Forty-fourth street warehouse. The trunk had been received here from Detroit June 17.

The trunk was shipped through the American Railway Express company to this city by a man giving the name of "A. A. Tieturn, of 105 Harper street, Detroit," according to the records accompanying the baggage, the police say. It was addressed to "James Douglas, New York City," they declare.

Express company officials said that they had held the trunk at the depot baggage room for several days, but when it was unclaimed they had sent it to the storeroom.

The police said they will immediately request the Detroit police to locate the man mentioned in the record as the sender of the trunk.

Believing that the trunk contained perishable merchandise, one of the expressmen opened it and found the woman's body. It had been jammed into the trunk and the clothes apparently had been thrown in afterward.

There were no marks of violence on the body, express company employees said. The police immediately took possession of the trunk and its contents for investigation.

The body, which had been covered over with feminine wearing apparel of good material, had been crammed into the trunk, which is 2 1-2 feet high and 3 feet long. The trunk, which was bound with a clothes line, was so crowded by its contents that it bulged at the side.

The woman was apparently 25 to 30 years old, the police say, and weighed about 130 pounds, had blue eyes and had been fairly good looking. Two upper teeth of her

left jaw slightly protruded, but this is believed to be a natural deformity.
