After Lapse of 28 Years Woman Still Wants Divorce.

A dispatch from Towanda, Pa., says: Feeble with the weight of years, yet determined in manner, Mrs. Hanna Harrison entered the court house yesterday and demanded the papers in a divorce suit granted her 28 years ago. Prothonotary Estell spent two hours searching the records, and finally found that back in the eighties Mrs. Harrison had been granted a divorce from James Harrison on the grounds of desertion. The decree was to become effective when Mrs. Harrison paid the costs of the case. The conditions were explained to the aged woman and she said she knew all about it and was ready to pay the costs as required.

Then she explained that about the time the divorce was applied for she heard her husband was dead and she decided that a divorce was not necessary. A few days ago he returned, after an absence of over thirty years, and she decided to lift the decree. She accordingly paid the costs and was given the papers, which restores her maiden name.

"I put him out of my life forever when I applied for the divorce, and now I intend to keep him out," said the woman, as she placed the court's decree in her handbag and left the court house.

NAVAL MEASURE PASSES HOUSE.

Two Battleships this Year—"Little Navy" Lost 201 to 106.

Washington, May 7.—The House today passed without a roll call the annual naval appropriation bill carrying \$139,560,334, and providing for the entire administration naval construction program. The building program includes two battleships, one to be built in some government navy yard, six torpedo boat destroyers, one sea-going torpedo boat, three coast defense submarine-torpedo boats, to be constructed on the Pacific coast, and four submarines.

The "little navy" men made their final stand against two battleships on a motion to send the bill back to the committee, which was defeated 201 to 106. Democratic Leader Underwood, Republican Leader Mann and other prominent figures in the House supported the motion.

NOTICE OF ELECTION OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES.

To the Trustees of the Various School Districts in Oconee County, South Carolina:

The trustees of each school district are hereby appointed to hold and conduct, at the school building in their respective districts, on Saturday, 16th day of May, 1914, a primary election for the purpose of nominating and recommending to the County Board of Education, for appointment, the names of three suitable qualified electors to serve as school trustees for their respective districts for a period of two years, or until their successor is appointed and qualified.

All white citizens above the age of 21 years are entitled to cast their ballot in said election, who are residents of said school district.

Polls to open at 1 o'clock p. m. and close at 4 o'clock p. m.

The managers shall take the usual oath to conduct said election fairly and impartially, and that each resident who shall offer to vote that he is a qualified elector.

The trustees, as managers, shall tabulate the vote and make true and correct return of said election to the County Board of Education within five days after the holding of said election.

This provision for the selection of trustees is not mandatory, but opportunity is given each school district to thus recommend men for their trustees if they so choose.
