CHARLESTON AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL ASSOCIATION.—At the last meeting of the County Agricultural Society, the following gentlemen were appointed to attend at the re-organization of this Society to be held in Charleston during the month of May: Capt. Murray Robinson, Col. Paul S. Felder, Dr. J. H. O' Cain, Col. A. P. Auaker, Capt. John L. Moor.

The Governor has appointed Simeon Corley, Commissioner of Agricultural Statistics, vice Henry Sparnick removed.

He has also commuted the sentence of the younger Nixon, recently sentenced in Charleston to be executed for murder, to imprisonment for life in the penitentiary. The older Nixon will suffer the extreme penalty of the law.

The cotton crop of 1869 was three million bales. At 25 cents per pound it is equal to a crop of six million bales before the war. Its entire value allowing 460 pounds to the bale is \$45,000,000.

The Governor will leave for New York on Saturday, on business connected with the Executive Department.

The Charleston Daily News, has been giving pen and ink sketches of the members of our Legislature. It speaks thus of Mr. F. McMara, member from Orangeburg: "Francis DeMara is one of the most respectable Radical representatives in the House, and appeared to be thoroughly disgusted with the company he was in."

There is a startling rumor in Paris that Napoleon is dead and that a bogus emperor has been presiding at the Tuilleries for several months.

Stewart and Claflin, the kings of New York dry goods, have reduced their prices in view of the approach of specie payments. This is the forerunner of what must follow with all dealers, in all commodities over the country.

The New York Herald of Tuesday says: "The State agent of South Carolina advises in another column that he will pay the April interest on the new bonds in coin at his office in this city. Under a recent law authorizing a sinking fund about a million dollars of the State debt will be redeemed this year, the State treasurer having at his disposal for that purpose \$2,754,000 of real estate, located principally in the City of Charleston."

It would seem, from the telegrams and paragraphs in our exchanges, that the resumption of specie payments, so to speak, is becoming quite prevalent among the retail dealers in various parts of the country.

The snow storm which commenced on Sunday last covered an area extending from the latitudes of North Carolina into the New Dominion, and from the Rocky Mountains to the Atlantic seaboard.

The farmers of Texas and adjoining countries, Texas, are introducing Mexican peons for the cultivation of cotton. The result of the New Hampshire election on Tuesday, shows a Republican loss of 1800 voters.

A barrel of flour sent from New York to Omaha at the rate per ounce charged for mail matter would cost \$240.

A Texas paper says that Mr. Reagan, formerly Confederate States Postmaster General, is now a Radical.

The President has promised to send ten thousand soldiers to Utah, if Mr. Cullom's anti-polygamy bill passes Congress.
