THE UTE MASSACRE.

Particulars of the Outrage—The Cause of the Outbreak.

RAVINES, WYOMING, Oct. 2, 1879. The following is a true and correct account of the massacre of Major Thornburgh, second, and thirteen privates by the Ute Indians, obtained from the courier who was with the soldiers from Captain Payne after the fight.

THE CAUSE OF THE OUTBREAK. Upon inquiry at the Indian Bureau, as to the probable cause of the recent Indian outbreak in the Colorado Territory, the following facts were learned:
