ACCIDENTAL SHOOTING.—A distressing accident occurred yesterday morning, which resulted in the serious wounding of Richard Popper, colored. Mr. King Apple, who keeps a store at the corner of King Street and Burns Lane, had purchased a number of old guns and muskets, with the intention of selling them again. These guns were lying on his counter, and were being examined by several customers, when his little son, while handling them, accidentally discharged one, the ball entering Popper's thigh, near the hip, and passing through the leg. The wounded man was taken to the Roper Hospital, where he received every attention. On dressing and probing the wound several pieces of bone were taken out, but it is not supposed to be necessarily mortal. The musket which was discharged was supposed to be unloaded, and the accident is deemed to have been a mere accident.

ARTHUR STROVING, Esq., being Vice President, and Col. BENJ. AUSTIN, Corresponding Secretary.

The purpose of this Board is to collect facts with reference to the advantages peculiar to different sections of the country; with reference to the inducements offered by particular States, organizations and individuals; with reference to localities adapted to different nationalities, trades, professions and occupations; with reference to ocean and inland transportation; with reference to the cost, facilities and commercial advantages of particular localities in foreign countries.

It will seek to make itself a central and national organization, to which all kindred ones may be made auxiliary; and while it will not lend its aid individually to particular localities, corporations, or individuals, it will be the medium through which all interests may be represented. It will seek to enlighten and to prompt emigrants from misrepresentation and fraud, and to promote the general prosperity of the country.
