

It is said that General Babcock, accompanied by General Rufus Ingalls, left New York a day or two ago for St. Domingo, with sealed instructions from the President, and it is surmised in connection with the proposition of President Baez to annex the island to the United States. Baez, it is also said, will shortly submit the annexation proposition to a vote of his people. The annexation terms will be an assumption of the public debt of St. Domingo and a purchase of the public buildings, forts, &c.

On and after the 1st of January next, the exchange of mails between the United States and France will cease, in consequence of the abrogation of the present postal convention between them. All letters sent hence after that date must be prepaid at the rate of ten cents per half ounce or under, and newspapers two cents each, the same rates to be collected on letters and papers received here at the office of delivery.

Of the 991 prelates who will be present at the CEumenical Council, three are ninety-five years of age, two others are ninety and upward, and twenty more are octogenarians.
