SEC. 3. On the completion of said jail, according to contract, and after it shall have been approved and received by the said Commissioners, they shall be authorized to draw upon the County Treasurer of Barnwell in favor of the contractor for the amount agreed to be paid therefor, which draft shall be paid by the Treasurer on presentation; but the said Commissioners are authorized, in said Commissioners are authorized, in their discretion, to stipulate for payment to the contractor in instalments as the work progresses: Provided, That no such payment shall be made except upon an estimate furnished in writing by the contractor, and carefully examined by the Commissioners, showing the amount of work actually done, and of material actually furnished, at the date when payment is asked: And provided, further, That there shall be reserved of such estimates twenty cents per centum, which shall not be paid to the contractor until the jail shall be completed according to contract, approved and received by the Commissioners.
