The following is the statutes of this Territory which will apply to reckless shooting where a person is killed:

Sec. 2. Such killing, when perpetrated from a premeditated design to effect the death of a person killed, if any human being shall be convicted of the same, shall suffer the punishment of death...

When perpetrated by an act imminently dangerous to others, and evincing a depraved mind, regardless of human life, although without any premeditated design to effect the death of any particular individual...

Sec. 15. Every other killing of a human being in any other manner, by the act, procurement or culpable negligence of another, where such killing is not justifiable or excusable, or is not declared in this chapter murder of one of the degrees already defined, shall be deemed murder in the fifth degree.
