
THE POOR MAN'S FRIEND.
 A Chapter From The Life of Wm. H. English, of Indiana.
 On this page we give a striking cut which very forcibly illustrates the manner in which the Democratic candidate for Vice President has treated the poor of Indiana. No country on the globe has suffered so much from the cruelty of landlords as unhappy Ireland. The accounts of the eviction scenes enacted there have saddened the hearts of thousands of people in every land. But there are probably few Irish landlords who have more relentlessly pursued the wretched people who have fallen into their power, than W. H. English, the Democratic candidate for Vice-President. The ring of the sheriff's hammer became familiar and sweet music to his dull ear, and the wail of the orphan and homeless mother, and the pitiable appeal of the miserable father, whom the panic had thrown out of employment, only seemed to make still harder the hard heart of the relentless and unfeeling man. How, now, can any poor laboring man afford to cast a vote for Wm. H. English? Since the panic Wm. H. English has foreclosed 530 mortgages, bought in 219 pieces of property at tax sales, and has obtained deeds from the sheriff of Marion County for 123 pieces.
