Agnew has settled down to the full realization of his position, but says that the hope of an ultimate pardon strengthens his spirit. His time has been reduced for good conduct, and I find that he has made himself generally popular with all the officers from the highest to the lowest."

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THE SOUTHERN'S SPLENDID NEW ALL-THE-YEAR EASTERN SERVICE

The new trains, numbers 33 and 34, known as the "New York and Florida Express," recently inaugurated by the Southern Railway System, giving the best through service to the northern cities that Florida has ever had, according to an announcement recently made, are to be operated the year round.

This train arrives at Baltimore at 9:12 a. m.; Philadelphia, 11:35 a. m.; New York, 2:03 p. m.

The United States fast mail trains, 35 and 36, remain unchanged, leaving at 8 p. m. for the North.

The money so kindly advanced by Trustee Simon Benjamin to purchase the much needed school bell has been refunded.

Thursday morning from 9 to 12 the work of the pupils will be on exhibition at the school rooms, and the public is cordially invited to inspect the same.

Friday evening at 8:30 the closing exercises will be held.

The school is doing excellent work under the leadership of Professor Hartwell, who is eminently qualified for the duties of his exacting position, and who is efficiently and zealously served by a capable corps of assistant teachers.
