A HUNDRED THOUSAND ACRES

Big Land Deal Consummated by Ocala and Tampa Parties

C. C. Todd, the prominent timber man of Ocala, was in the city yesterday. Mr. Todd, in conjunction with Thomas M. Weir of this city, has just closed a deal for the purchase of 105,000 acres of land in Franklin and Liberty counties, one of the largest purchases of property on record in this state.

The land was purchased from the Apalachicola Lumber Company. It will be used for sawmill and turpentine purposes. Forty thousand acres of the tract is in fine cypress timber.

Messrs. Todd and Weir have been engaged upon this deal for the past three months. The papers have now been exchanged, and the new owners will take possession at once. The amount changing hands on the deal amounted to almost a hundred thousand dollars. Tampa Tribune of 22nd.

Mr. Todd left today for the scene of the purchase to show the land to a prospective buyer. Mr. Todd told the Star man that the deal is authentic and that there were three partners equally interested, Judge Baron Phillips of Tampa being the other.
