

## SATURDAY'S PRIMARY

The Citizens' Ticket Won by a Large Majority

The Ocala precinct primary battle has been fought, and the citizens' ticket suggested last Friday night in the open door meeting carried the day by a majority of 170, counting the highest and lowest of the opposing forces.

The contest was a strenuous one, but, as usual, in such contests, when the people are aroused and determined to assert that "we are the people," they won, hands down, and those who posed, or would like to pose as leaders and directors, bit the dust and tasted of its dregs.

The count was not completed before 1:30 Sunday morning.

The following is the vote polled and the first twelve were elected delegates to the county convention, Saturday:

It will be seen that for delegates Hon. R. A. Burford led the victorious ticket by 9 votes, and that Don McIver, the people's leader, was next, receiving 288 votes.

While the opposition asservated in the morning, high and low, that they would swipe the earth with the citizens' ticket, they reckoned without their host.

Many regrets are expressed at Mr. Zewadski's defeat, but all assert that it was of his own seeking. Had he put his ear to the earth in the morning he could have plainly heard the mutterings of discontent and displeasure at the manner in which he spoke of the rank and file of the party at the Friday night meeting. For this they laid him low.

Had Mr. Z. come out in the open as did Don McIver and said, "Let the boys have a show," he, too, would have been in the victorious procession.

It was not because they loved Zewadski less, but because of the love they bore the inestimable rights guaranteed to them under the terms of our constitution and the principles of Thomas Jefferson, that every member of the party in open door meeting had a right to be heard.


