Oscar Burnett, who saw the struggle and knowing both were in danger of drowning, though he could not swim, attempted to reach them on a long log that extended into the pond. When near the struggling swimmers he slipped into the water and, being beyond his depth, he, too, would have drowned, but young Smoak, seeing Burnett's impending fate, made a heroic effort and saved Burnett's life. Young Smoak's struggle with Cox is still apparent, his eyes being all bloodshot.

It was a sad affair and, sorrowful as it was, it came near craping the hearths of other homes.
