BOARD OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

Ocala, Fla., August 16, 1900.

To School Patrons and Supervisors: The teachers for all schools have been appointed, and I ask you to notify your teacher at once as to the date the patrons wish the school to be opened. It is necessary that I should know the date of opening at once, in order to contract with teachers. The Board has ordered that no school can begin before the second Monday, 10th day of September, and that schools be allowed to open any time during September until the first Monday in October, to best accommodate the patrons.

I wish to call your attention to the following:

1. The Board has declared that it will not pay for holidays, and a full month of twenty school days must be actually taught; that Thanksgiving, New Year and Christmas must be given as holidays, but will not be paid for.

2. That no teacher will be allowed to teach on Saturday to make up a holiday or lost time.

3. That on account of the income for the school funds being much less than previous years, from falling valuations of the assessed property, the Board has been compelled to even run a five months' term; to cut off all repairs, and no sum has been set apart for either repairs, furniture or new buildings, and patrons are requested not to make application for such. We have about thirty desks on hand and will be glad to know what schools are in need of desks.

4. I hope that each supervisor will examine the school house and in some way see that it is made comfortable before school begins. A child can do more than twice the work in a comfortable house than in one uncomfortable. It is the duty of every parent to see that the house in which his children are compelled to sin from 8:30 a. m. to 4 p. m., is made comfortable. It is much cheaper to spend a few dollars on repairs than to keep your children at home or to pay twice the amount for medicine or doctor's bills.

5. We wish to make this term of school the very best in the history of the county. We can do it, if patrons will co-operate and work with the teachers. If you do not, your school will be a failure, while you and your children will be the sufferers. The Board has acted in what it believes to be for the best interest to the pupils, believing that the Board is better prepared to judge the competency of a teacher than the majority of patrons, who give the question but little thought.

6. The first of July of each year is the time fixed by law to make appointments of teachers. The Board recognizes the right of any patron in the county to make recommendations or complaints before the Board, but when patrons keep silence until the time is past, teachers appointed and notified of their appointments, the Board holds that then patrons have no claims on the Board to change such appointments.

7. If your teacher does not exactly suit you, remember that the Board gave the matter careful consideration, and did what it thought was best, and now asks you to throw aside all petty differences, welcome your teacher and help him or her to make the school a success. Yours respectfully,


