A SUPREME COURT DECISION

Upholds the Cause of Polk County Prohibitionists

This is a case in which the plaintiff in 1896 sought a license to sell liquor in Polk county, from the county commissioners, but being refused on the ground that the election of 1894 on the question of license or no license had shown the citizens to be opposed to license, addressed himself to the circuit court judge for a mandamus to force the commissioners to grant the license. The circuit judge, on hearing argument, issued the mandamus. The commissioners were represented by their attorney, Mr. Eppes Tucker. They thereupon took an appeal by their counsel to the supreme court. The supreme court now reverses the decision of the circuit judge, and the election of 1894 stands good against license for the sale of liquor in our county.

The election on the same question subsequent to the one brought into question by the one tested in this case has also been recently sustained by the decision of Judge Wall. So that the county has triumphed in both cases.—Bartow Courier-Informant.

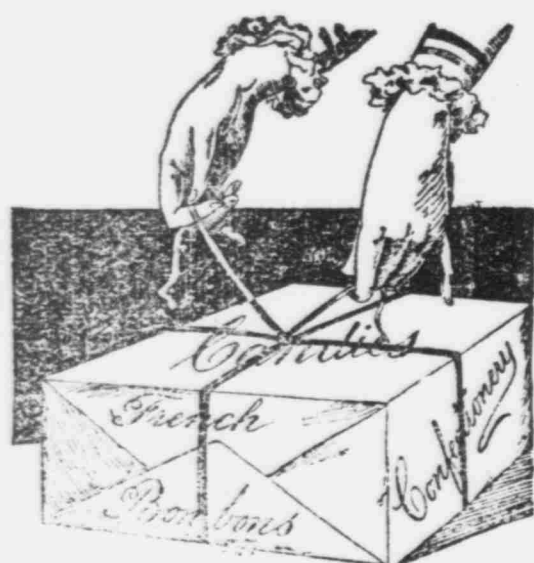

IT LEADS ALL OTHERS

Secretary Wilson's Opinion of Florida Tobacco

"The tobacco exhibit at Paris was one of the largest and most complete exhibits which has ever been made. It contained over 2000 samples, representing all the commercial types and grades of tobacco produced in this country, including the various export types and our domestic manufacturing and cigar types. Two very important points came out in the awards of the jury. The Florida-grown Sumatra tobacco was awarded 20 points of merit against 18 points for the tobacco submitted from the island of Sumatra, and the Florida-grown leaf was admittedly a thinner leaf with much more elasticity. It took twenty-five more leaves in the sixteenth-inch size to make a pound of the domestic than of the foreign-grown leaf. This is a matter for congratulation, and will undoubtedly secure a name and a market for the Florida product, which, on account of the prejudice for foreign-grown products, it would have been difficult to secure for the Florida crop. The bright yellow tobacco of North Carolina was awarded the same number of points as the Turkish tobacco with which it came into competition."
