IT LEADS ALL OTHERS

Secretary Wilson's Opinion of Florida Tobacco

"The tobacco exhibit at Paris was one of the largest and most complete exhibits which has ever been made. It contained over 2000 samples, representing all the commercial types and grades of tobacca produced in this country, including the various export types and our domestic manufacturing and cigar types. Two very important points came out in the awards of the jury. The Florida-grown Sumatra tobacco was awarded 20 points of merit against 18 points for the tobacco subaside for you till mitted from the island of Sumatra, and the Florida-grown leaf was admittedly a thinner leaf with much more elasticity. It took twenty-five more leaves in the sixteenth-inch size to make a pound of the domestic than of the foreign-grown leaf. This is a matter for congratulation, and will undoubtedly secure a name and a market for the Florida product, which, on account of the prejudice for foreigngrown products, it would have been difficult to secure for the Florida crop. The bright yellow tobacco of North Carolina was awarded the same number of points as the Turkish tobacco with which it came into competition.'
