COMMITTEE MEETING

Extensive Preparations Being Made to Entertain the Teachers of the State

The committees for the State Teachers' Association met last night in the council chamber. Those present were H. A. Ford, D. S. Williams, Jno. R. Martin, W. D. Condon, E. P. Thagard, W. D. Carn and Principal Varn.

The question of music was gone over and Mr. Condon was requested to get a good violinist to lead the orchestra.

Mr. Thagard reported that Mr. Stevens, manager of the Ocala House, tendered the use of the parlors and dining room for the night of the teachers' reception and it was gratefully accepted.

On the suggestion of Mr. Varn, Gov. Jennings and Congressman R. W. Davis and Stephen M. Sparkman were invited to be present on reception night and President H. A. Ford, of the Ocala Board of Trade, was authorized to extend the same.

In the matter of excursions Mr. Williams reported that Mr. H. L. Anderson would have his Vinegar Route ready and would make all teachers a nominal rate, while Captain Hutton Howard, of the Sophie Howard, Ocala-waha and Silver Springs line, would do all he could to show the educators of the state the beauties and wonders of Silver Springs.

The hackmen would make a greatly reduced rate to and from the depots and to the Springs, while Mr. Edwards, of the Ocala House, would tender the use of his steam launch Helen at the Springs, as did the Golf Club their well kept grounds.

The committees are very much encouraged at the way our people are taking hold of this proposed gathering.

The editor of the Star was delegated to get up a booklet telling of the good points and spots of interest in and around Ocala. The committee will meet next Monday night.
