A QUINTUPLE MURDER

AWFUL TRAGEDY AT HASTINGS

William Austin Kills a Man and Three Women, Tries to Murder Two Children, and Winds Up by Killing Himself

(Metropolis, May 19)

Hastings, May 19.—William Wilkinson and wife, sister, Amanda Wilkinson, and niece, Bertha McCullar, aged 13, were all murdered in their home here last night, and the lifeless body of William Austin was found lying beside that of Bertha, with a revolver clenched in his hand. All the parties are white.

Bertha McCullar had lived in Jacksonville some time. Her mother died a short time ago, and she came here to live with her uncle, William Wilkinson. Austin paid attention to Bertha in Jacksonville, and came here a week ago and made efforts to marry the girl.

On Saturday Austin went to St. Augustine and procured a marriage license, and secured a justice on Saturday night to perform the marriage. Upon his arrival at the Wilkinson home the girl was found crying, and on being questioned by the justice she claimed she did not want to marry, as she was too young and did not care for Austin.

The justice advised Austin to wait until Monday, and allow him to investigate the matter, which was agreed upon. All seemed quiet yesterday, but the neighbors heard the report of a revolver early this morning, and upon examination found five lifeless bodies and two children, aged two and three respectively, unconscious. They had been beaten on the head with a revolver.

The children are not seriously injured. The eldest child claims that after shooting the others Austin knocked them in the head with a revolver, and then lying beside the girl he loved he ended his own life. An inquest is now being held.

Another Account

St. Augustine, May 19.—News has just reached this city of a terrible tragedy at Hastings, on the East Coast Railway, seventeen miles from St. Augustine, in which six people lost their lives. The terrible affair occurred at 3 o'clock this morning, when William Austin went to the home of William Wilkinson, shot and killed Mr. and Mrs. Wilkinson and Mr. Wilkinson's sister, Miss Wilkinson, and Mrs. Wilkinson's sister, Miss Bertha McCullar, and Mr. and Mrs. Wilkinson's daughter, Miss Malina Wilkinson, leaving only a child two years old alive in the house. After killing the five, Austin placed the pistol to his head and killed himself.

It is said the cause of the shooting was due to Austin's wanting to marry Miss McCullar, aged 13 years, but was rejected by the young girl and her sister, Mrs. Wilkinson, which led to the shooting. Austin was about thirty years of age and a native of Tallahassee. The Wilkinson family were residents of Hastings for many years.

Justice of the Peace Mackey and a number of citizens have left here for the scene.
